HOME REPAIR

Minor home repair assistance is available to help low income homeowners with home repairs or activities that eliminate conditions that pose health and safety threats to the residents. Eligible activities or repairs include electrical, heating or plumbing systems, roofs and structural repairs. Properties must be owner occupied, the household must meet income guidelines. Assistance will be in the form of a grant.

PRIVATE REHABILITATION

Housing rehabilitation assistance is available to help low and moderate income homeowners with more extensive housing needs. All major systems in the house will be inspected and brought up to the program's Residential Rehab Standards. Eligible repairs include electrical, heating, plumbing, roofs, foundations, windows, doors, lead paint remediation. Additionally, repairs may address interior surfaces and floor coverings. Properties must be owner occupied and the household must meet income guidelines.
